The Nancy Floyd Haworth Foundation annual benefit luncheon will be held **Saturday, May 7, 2011 at the Embassy Suites Hotel in Albuquerque at 12:00 Noon.** This year's keynote speaker is the nationally known breast cancer survivor and author, **Geralyn Lucas.** Ms. Lucas' speech is entitled "*Why I Wore Lipstick to My Mastectomy,*" also the title of her best selling book. Diagnosed at 27, Lucas wanted to share her story to help dispel the myth that breast cancer discriminates by age. Ms. Lucas has appeared on many national television broadcasts, has been reviewed in SELF magazine and inspired a Stila cosmetic company lipstick called "Geralyn." Her presentation promises to be filled with humor, courage and inspirational candor.

Two free public seminars will be held prior to the luncheon. One will feature the outstanding local medical professional, **Dr. Arti Prasad,** of the UNM Center for Life. Dr. Prasad will speak on the subject of Integrative Medicine and the relationship

to breast cancer treatment. A second seminar will feature a panel of breast cancer survivors who represent local organizations currently receiving grant funding from the NFHF. They will share their personal experiences in dealing with this disease. Seminars begin at 9:30 AM and participants may attend both sessions.
